



Dear SharperBlade:

“We cut over 35 feet of old Ivy back 2-3 feet NO PROBLEM! Next we attacked grass along a long rock wall several times NO PROBLEM! I edged a multitude of sidewalks and driveways with no difficulty. As a side note, we found that it equals the power steel bladed edger's sharper crisper look you want and completed in half the time. The gas powered edger people will find this as a competitive threat - one less piece of equipment to store.

Now the harshest test, 60 feet of over grown broken concrete path, but before I attacked the path I trimmed a 6-foot Azalea. It came out as good as or better than using the power sheers, and in a lot less time. Getting back to the broken concrete path, this is a time consumer. You have to start with a full spool of the heavy line and a lot of patients. The SharperBlade took about 20 minutes to handle this project. The best part was not having to keep taking the head off and fixing the line. As a side note, the "prop wash" generated by the blade was able to clear away the cuttings so I could see where I trimmed and where I needed to trim.

As hard as I used it, and I do mean, "ABUSED" the SharperBlade, it operated flawlessly. The work completed would have needed 2 additional pieces of equipment and 3-4 spool reloads. I find it safer than the metal blades I've used. I've had steel blades shatter sending the fast moving projectiles hundreds of feet and damaging property. SharperBlade is a lot safer and more forgiving. Back to work...”
